An In-Depth 6-Year Program rooted in Qur'anic knowledge, enriched by essential Islamic sciences, and dedicated to purposeful community service.

Program Purpose

This advanced-level course is designed for committed sisters who wish to deepen their connection with the Quran, enhance their Islamic scholarship, and actively engage in dawah and community leadership. Through a blend of intensive study and hands-on field work, students are trained to become educators and role models who implement Islamic teachings in real life.

Eligibility Criteria

To enroll:

- Applicants must have successfully completed Tafseer and Tajweed of Qur'an from ArRahmah or any other recognized Islamic institute.
- A tajweed assessment will be conducted as part of the admission process. Basic fluency in Quranic recitation is required.

Subjects Covered

1. Word-by-Word Quranic Analysis

Understand each ayah through its root meanings, grammar, and structure, building a lasting connection with the Quranic language.

2. Tafseer with Practical Reflection

Gain insight into the context and application of verses for personal and societal reform.

3. Word Meaning Tests

A test will be uploaded after every half Juz to reinforce vocabulary. Students must print, complete, and email their responses as instructed.

4. Hadith Studies

Students will study authentic narrations from Sahih Bukhari, accompanied by detailed explanations and practical lessons relevant to everyday life. To ensure comprehension, regular quizzes will be conducted to assess understanding and reinforce learning.

5. Hifz Requirements

Students must memorize one of the following pairs:

- **Option 1:** Surah Al-Baqarah & Surah Al-Mulk
- **Option 2:** Surah Aal-e-Imran & Surah Al-Kahf

Important Notes:

- **Students conducting audio classes monthly or delivering monthly dars session will be exempt from memorizing Surah Al-Mulk or Al-Kahf.**
- **If a student has already memorized the required Surahs, she must conduct audio/dars sessions twice a month and begin memorizing Surah As-Sajdah.**

6. Usul al-fiqh and Islami Aqaa'id

This course offers a strong foundation in both Islamic jurisprudence and core beliefs. Through Usul al-Fiqh, students explore how rulings are derived from the Qur'an and Sunnah using principles like ijma (consensus), qiyas (analogy), and ijtihad (independent reasoning). The Islami Aqaa'id component reinforces key beliefs, including the Oneness of Allah, prophethood, the Hereafter, and divine decree. Together, these subjects provide a comprehensive understanding of Islamic law and creed, nurturing clarity and conviction. Periodic quizzes will be conducted to assess comprehension and reinforce learning.

7. Arabic Grammar

Students will study essential grammar rules that enable them to understand the Quran in its original Arabic form and become independent learners.

8. Field Work & Community Service

Students are expected to:

- Visit elderly homes, orphanages, women’s shelters, soup kitchens, or hospitals every 6 months with a team. For that, they need to form and lead a social work team in their locality.
- Each student is required to either conduct an audio class per month (by playing Ustazah’s recordings) or deliver a dars session themselves.

If you have already memorized the surahs mention above in hifz section, then you have to conduct audio class twice a month (by playing Ustazah’s recordings) or deliver two dars session themselves per month.

*All sisters conducting audio classes will be trained and mentored by ArRahmah Admins.

9. Conduct Quiz

ATQ students are expected to organize **a quiz upon the completion of each Juz** to reinforce learning and assess understanding of the content covered.

10. Dawah Participation

- Students are required to organize or participate in at least **four dawah booths** annually to promote Islamic awareness. They are responsible for maintaining a log or keeping a record of their dawah activities to meet the course requirements.
- If a student is not able to participate physically (case-by-case review), she must join the calling team and make weekly Dawah calls.

*Training will be provided to all calling team and dawah volunteers

11. Mentoring & Monitoring group discussions

You may be asked to Monitor group discussions and support peer learning by helping other students in groups.

*All social work, dawah, and outreach participants will receive structured training and ongoing support, In Sha Allah.

*There will be no written assignments or group activities for ATQ students.
